Visitors Visa – Zimbabwean Nationals are now required to get a Visitors Visa before travelling to New Zealand. In Africa the visa can only be obtained from The New Zealand High Commission in Pretoria. Currently there are 2385 Zimbabweans in New Zealand on temporary permits.

When applying for a Visa the following is required

- Completed Application Form Payment of Fee
- Passport
- Evidence of financial support in NZ
- Evidence of funds, or sponsorship by NZ resident or citizen.
- Evidence of onward travel from NZ, return ticket or funds to purchase a return ticket.

The New Zealand High Commission is very strict. The service requires evidence that the applicant is able to return to a country where he/she lawfully resides.

Fees

There is a suspension of visa free entry for one year expiring 20th February 2004.

If you are unable to renew your Zimbabwe passport because of perceived alternate citizenship, Trevor has researched the situation & he will happily e-mail a copy of his informative letter to anybody interested.

Botswana

Emigrating from Botswana, or have lived in Botswana at any time. Police Clearance. Go to any of the larger police stations for fingerprinting (explain it is for clearance from Criminal Records Bureau) this will take half an hour or so depending on the queue. Take your passports. We went to Central Police Station first & were told they were too busy & to try another station instead. We had success at Broadhurst. Once this has been done take the completed forms to Police Headquarters, which are behind Bank of Botswana. Ask to see someone from Criminal Records Bureau. Tell them you need clearance for emigration to New Zealand. Bring: copies of passports, copies of work & residence permits, & obviously original of fingerprint forms. Clearance should take about three to four days & doesn't cost anything. The police we dealt with were very helpful. Medical Clearance. For the Medical you need to see Dr Lambat who is in Broadhurst. Bring passports, the NZ medical forms & any immunisation cards. Bring cash & or credit card as cheques are not accepted.

First off they take blood & urine samples & you will then be sent to the Gaborone Private Hospital for the chest X rays. The Private Hospital will need to be paid directly. Once X rays are done it is back to Dr Lambats for the medical.

Container shipments – choose carefully. Kamina Kawena is unable to give any accurate information.

Customs & Quarantine

Acquaint yourself with the customs & quarantine requirements if you are moving to New Zealand. These will be provided to you when you are granted residence.

English Language Requirement

With the new rules introduced in November 2002 by NZIS regarding the English requirement for applications, all Zimbabweans must now have letters from their schools saying that they were at school for at least 5 years & the language they were taught in was English. School certificates are not sufficient any more. The schools are very co-operative as they have been doing a lot of these letters. If the letters are not provided the applications will not be accepted.

New Zealand Inland Revenue

Apply for a tax number (the first thing you should do on arrival) & essential info www.ird.govt.nz

Police Clearance

If you are having problems & it is not forthcoming or that if it appears that the Police Certificate is unavailable then a Statutory Declaration may be needed to be made through a lawyer outlining what has been done in attempting to obtain police clearance – so keep notes. If you are having trouble then contact your local NZ MPs office.

1. Get fingerprint forms – 3 each (2 required). In New Zealand the NZ Police can supply fingerprint forms (POL 605 12/99). An administrative fee may be charged.
2. Phone CID to see which police stations are able to take fingerprints.
3. Go to police station early with soap, towel & the current fee.
4. Make an appointment at the police station to have your finger prints taken.

5. Obtain an official receipt when you pay.
6. Ask the policeman who took the fingerprints to sign the forms.
7. Take the fingerprint forms to CID. Do NOT go between 10:00 – 10:30 (teatime) & 1:00 – 2:00 (lunchtime). YOU WILL NOT BE SERVED. Don't bother to get an agent to do this for you CID are efficient & helpful.
8. Complete a Form 137.
9. The Form 137 will be stapled to the fingerprint forms. Check that the receipt number is written at the top of the Form 137.
10. Police Clearance fees are as follows:
 - \$3500 – same day clearance
 - \$2500 – clearance within 2 working days
 - \$2000 – clearance within 7 working days
11. You may send anyone to collect your police clearance or you may opt to have CID post the documentation to you.
12. Make sure the CID have spelt everything correctly – names, birth dates, etc. – mistakes that will hold up your application.
13. Criminal Records Dept phone: Harare 700171 ext. 3121 is very helpful

Police Clearance Other Countries

If you have lived for periods of 12 months or more in any other countries during the last 10 years, you must obtain additional police clearances from these countries, & also your country of citizenship." Available information also indicates that if you hold a passport other than a Zimbabwean passport, you may need to apply for police clearance from that country, even if you have never lived there – this information is unsubstantiated.

United Kingdom Request a 'Person Record: Prosecution/Criminal History' form from the National Identification Service Room 1229 Metro Police Service London SW1 HOBG. Ph: (020) 7230 4028. Complete the form & sent it together with £10 (GB Pounds) per person; original ID (e.g. Zimbabwean National Registration); proof of present NZ physical address, e.g. a utility bill addressed to the applicant at NZ address. Reply takes +/- 40 days.

Scotland Request a "Scottish Criminal Record Office Subject Access Request" from the National Identity Service.

Botswana Go to any of the larger police stations for fingerprinting (explain it is for clearance from Criminal Records Bureau) this will take half an hour or so depending on the queue. Take your passports. We went to Central Police Station first & were told they were too busy & to try another station instead. We had success at Broadhurst. Once this has been done take the completed forms to Police Headquarters, which are behind Bank of Botswana. Ask to see someone from Criminal Records Bureau. Tell them you need clearance for emigration to New Zealand. Bring: copies of passports, copies of work & residence permits, & obviously original of fingerprint forms. Clearance should take about three to four days & doesn't cost anything. The police are helpful.

Police Clearance Applying from Outside Zimbabwe

The Zimbabwean authorities state that the procedure is the same for people applying from overseas though payment & revenue stamps could prove a problem. Ph: Harare (04) 700171, PO Box CY683

Causeway Harare. Zimbabweans already in NZ who have sent the forms to friends in Zimbabwe have obtained police clearance. The process has been efficient & simple. If you apply from NZ – go to your local Police Station & request that they take your prints on a Form POL 605 12/99 & send with your application. If you go to have your fingerprints taken here in New Zealand – you have to have them done on a NZ form. You can then have certified copies taken in case your original gets lost in the post. Ensure the picture in your passport really does look like you & that your signature is the same. Take as many forms of identity as possible. If that doesn't work then get hold of NZ Immigration & explain your problem to them.

Annette du Plooy has offered her services to obtain Police Clearance on behalf of those applicants for Permanent Residency in New Zealand & Australia, she offers a three week lead time, & will send all documents via DHL. BEFORE YOU LEAVE ZIMBABWE

Certificates

Obtain **original** copies of all certificates before you leave Zimbabwe, including Birth, Death, Marriage, Divorce Order, Adoption Papers etc.

Driving Licence

Obtain an International Drivers Licence from the AA. (Useful if you are on a LSD visit)

Glasses/Contact Lenses

Get a document from your optician outlining your current prescription.

Medical Aid

If you belong to a medical aid society in Zimbabwe arrange for an "International Transfer Certificate" (include all members). This will facilitate obtaining medical insurance in NZ & you will not have the three month stand down period before you are able to claim.

Medical & Dental Records

Bring your dental records if you can & a covering letter from your doctor if necessary for any medical condition/medication. This will save you the costs of having all the investigations/tests done again.

Mobile Phones

GSM mobile phones from Zimbabwe will work in NZ with a NZ SIM card. You will need to buy a new charger, or an adapter for your charger.

Motor Vehicle Insurance

Obtain written confirmation of your no-claim bonus history, this can be used for your motor vehicle insurance in New Zealand & can save you as much as 60%.

Plugs

None of the 3-pin plugs on your electrical appliances will work in NZ – cut them off before you leave (save space) & replace when you arrive in NZ. Alternative is to purchase adapters in NZ. 2-pin plugs on shavers etc. bathroom type fitting are fine.

References

Obtain references before you leave, & make sure that they are people you will keep in touch with so that prospective employers are able to contact them once you start interviewing for jobs.

Tax Clearance

Recommended.

Zimbabwe Passports

Make sure that you have **more** than 3 years left before renewal is required from the time you arrive/intend to arrive in NZ.

It is essential that you apply for a tax number on arrival – you will need it to open a bank account amongst other things. www.ird.govt.nz To complete the IRD number application – individual (IR 595) the applicant will be required to send a photocopy of one of the following documents as identification:

- Birth Certificate
- 18+ card
- Overseas passport
- Photo-ID driver's licence.

Education

Schooling is compulsory in New Zealand from the age of 6, although most children start at 5. The school year commences in January & there are 4 school terms. A list of all schools is available at <http://www.tki.org.nz/e/schools/>. *State schools are zoned & some new residents choose accommodation accordingly.* Information on independent/private schools can be obtained from www.independent.school.nz/. Driving licence

In terms of the Geneva Convention on Road Traffic drivers from certain countries may drive on a domestic licence for a year before having to sit the same licence tests in New Zealand.

Zimbabweans – if you have a current overseas driver licence or a current international driving permit, you can drive for one year after you first arrive in New Zealand.

Check the LTSA website www.ltsa.govt.nz (road rules are under the 'Code Red 50kmph' sign at the bottom of the homepage)

- You may wish to obtain an International Drivers Licence from the AA before leaving Zimbabwe.
- Holders of a Zimbabwean Drivers Licence are required to obtain a New Zealand licence within a year of arriving in NZ. This involves both a theory & practical test.
- If the applicant holds a South African or British licence only the theory test is required to convert to a NZ licence.
- The applicant requires two forms of ID i.e. passport & either a bank statement, phone / electric bill to prove residential address, or New Zealand AA membership card.
- Fees (information available from [LTSA](http://www.ltsa.govt.nz))

Bank Account

It is possible to open a bank account in New Zealand up to six months before you arrive in the country. company & register for their focus groups / tasting panels or as a mystery shopper. Just don't admit to joining all the companies or doing market research very often.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Accommodation – renting jargon is slightly different in New Zealand. The bond is the one off payment to the landlord, which is lodged with the Bond Centre & will potentially offset any damage to the property, discovered when the premises are vacated. Rent can be weekly, fortnightly or monthly, & landlords may require that you set up a direct debit from your bank account rather than accepting a cheque.

Alarms – you will need a smoke alarm in your home in NZ. Most people change the batteries in their smoke alarms on the same days as they change the time on their clocks at the beginning & end of daylight savings time.

MISCELLANEOUS USEFUL TIPS & ADVICE

- If you are not used to life in a large city Auckland may be a bit daunting. Head to a smaller centre Hamilton & Tauranga areas are great.
- Life in NZ is very different – be prepared to adapt – you don't have to lose your identity, just mould with your new environment.
- In NZ schooling starts the day a child turns 5 & is compulsory.
- If you are invited to "tea" – it means that you go for dinner & if you are asked to bring a plate it means that you bring some food. If it is your birthday you "shout" your workmates cakes, beer, whatever i.e.; you bring a plate to work (good idea to let them know in advance & some may shout you).
- Situations vacant sections in the NZ papers are best checked on Saturdays & Wednesdays.
- If you smoke – give up – it is a very expensive habit in NZ & is unsociable.
- Zim passport holders currently do NOT have to pay for work permits nor for visas for children to attend school. (All other nationalities do have to pay)
- There are a lot of hurdles to cross when immigrating to NZ & finding work – one door closes, but another always opens.
- Immigrating to NZ is not a closed shop – most things are possible as long as you are prepared to be persistent but it does make life a LOT easier if you have qualifications in the required areas. The current government **are** showing sympathy towards migrants from Zimbabwe.
- Do not apply for refugee status to gain access to NZ – currently Zimbabwe is not recognised by the U.N. as having a refugee problem so the NZ govt **will not** grant you refugee status. If your application is refused you will be sent back to Zim & will not be allowed to apply for residency.
- You will pine for home & family left behind. This is normal. Best advice if you are serious about staying in New Zealand is do not regret what "might have been", don't look over your shoulder, look forward to your new future. & THINK POSITIVE!
- Take a proactive approach to seeking employment – place adverts in the local papers – tell them where you are from – I have heard of some good responses.
- Do NOT bring biltong or foodstuffs.
- On arrival if you need a fridge/freezer you may be best off to rent for \$35/month than to buy a 2nd hand one. By renting you get repairs for free as against a 2nd hand one which may pack up with no come back.
- Best bargains are to be found at Salvation Army shops & "Garage Sales". "Garage Sales" = cheepee sales from peoples homes at the weekend & are advertised in the local papers, get there early to beat the rush.
- Always haggle in NZ for whatever you are trying to get.
- Getting a job may be your biggest hurdle & you will probably have to come down a number of rungs from what you are used to – that's life just get on with it.

- You will find that Kiwis sometimes need urging to get things done especially in Govt Departments – the wheels of bureaucracy move slowly at times – be patient but make sure that you don't get forgotten.
- Stones might be bones but gold can be sold.
- Do not get involved in property transactions without consulting a lawyer *before* you sign the offer. The contract/property laws are different & complicated & the terminology is confusing, e.g. **settlement & bond** mean different things here than in Zim/SA. Unless you are an expert in English law you will not know what you are buying when it is leasehold or freehold or a cross-lease & there are pitfalls.
- Get credit for your no claim bonus by producing some proof of your claims history. You can reduce premiums by 60%.
- Check if your car will be allowed on the road before shipping it here. This also applies to fancy cars like Mercedes Benz.
- To open a bank account or borrow money you will usually need to prove your credit history so bring your last 3–6 months worth of bank statements with you as well as any proof if you had a loan or mortgage that you were making frequent payments to or had paid off. These 2 things will help to show a NZ bank that you are a good payer who has meet financial commitments in the past.
- Zim 'winter clothing' is generally not good enough in NZ. Remember to wear layers of clothes, keep your head & feet warm, & get polypropylene underwear – usually not very expensive.
- Oil column heaters are expensive to run – check with your power supply company for advice on power saving information. TrustPower give out good advice Free ph: 0800 87 87 87. Firewood is the cheapest heating & if you have a "wetback" (heat exchanger) fitted to your fire you cut your power costs to heat your water as well.
- Avoid getting involved in scam businesses – pyramid sales & the like, check it out – **if it's too good to be true then it's most likely a scam.** Check the Ministry of Consumer Affairs www.consumer-ministry.govt.nz or the Consumer Institute www.consumer.org.nz/
- Do not expect handouts in NZ – you will be competing on the open job market.
- Electrical goods from Zim will work fine in NZ, but the plugs are different & you will need to change them.
- Do NOT just rely on interaction & friendship with other Zimbabweans when you get to NZ. If you cut yourself off you will not be happy – your objective is citizenship so mould into the NZ ways. You don't have to lose your heritage or identity but you will not recreate what you wanted or had in Africa here in NZ. Set a good example – make it easy on yourself & for others following – don't mess up by giving us a bad name.
- No banking history – Westpac Trust will open a Save & Win account with no history required.
- Smith City will give credit for furniture items up to about \$2500 with a small deposit – also creates credit history for you.
- \$2 Shops are a cheap place to pick up basic kitchen items when cash trapped & starting out.
- 'RD' in addresses means Rural Delivery
- You may be allowed to bring certain seeds into NZ. You must declare it & you must have the species

specific name, i.e.; the Latin or specific name & be certified seed.

- Insist on a written contract when obtaining a job setting out all conditions of employment.
- It is vital to thoroughly review your CV & re-vamp & improve where necessary. **Nikki Herley** says "I applied for dozens of positions as Secretary/PA, but didn't get a single interview. I finally accepted that my CV needed some serious revision even though I had been told this before arriving in NZ. Someone within the recruitment industry offered to critique my CV & offer advice on job-hunting strategy etc. Based on her advice, I thoroughly revamped my CV & could not believe the response. Within a week of launching my new & improved CV, I was called for four interviews & offered two positions! I would be very pleased to pass on what I've learnt (pretty basic stuff!)." - When buying a business insist on **thoroughly** checking it out yourself (do not be fobbed off with inadequate answers) – a number of people are being burned in Australia & New Zealand from inadequate investigation of what they are purchasing/leasing. Spend money with a professionals who can help you – engage a lawyer as well as Credit Management International – people who can help you to reduce the risk – see Africans in Business above
- Ensure that you have the sufficient funds required to enter NZ – (NZ\$3000 per person) or you may be denied entry.
- Do not bring your Cadac gas cylinders to NZ – they will have to be tested before they can be refilled & the cost is more than buying a new locally made one. Parts & adapters for Cadac fittings are available.
- There are always problems with free e-mail accounts like Hotmail. Useful for a short time but when you can get a NZ ISP account.
- There are inaccuracies in some information regarding immigration prospects to NZ being circulated in Zimbabwe by some 'migration specialists'. Nothing is a 'dead cert' – you have to satisfy the criteria set down by NZIS. Carefully consider what you are doing & who you are spending your money with. Take full advantage of the good information & links offered to you above.
- Never be fooled that moving countries is easy – if you are not going to be tough & resilient – forget it
- Make sure that you find out, with accuracy, any visas that you may require while in transit to NZ – Australia for instance. Some travel agents seem to be making errors, so check with embassy of any countries that you intend to travel through
- There are an increasing number of accounts coming to me from people who have been 'done' by agencies offering migration services. Be careful who you use – only use reputable firms or one that a trusted friend has recommended to you.
- Medals & militaria & other items of historical value – don't leave them behind.
- Don't switch off when in NZ – we do have crime here, so keep it locked & use common sense
- There are not many bugs here but watch out for the white tailed spider, a migrant from Australia, it is up to 15mm long & can pack a nasty bite that can be very slow to heal. If you get bitten you may get blistering & ulceration – see a doctor.

There are two kinds of wars: those fought on battlefields with guns & bombs, waged by elders against their enemies; & those fought within a man's soul with conscience & remorse. The one is external, a public war for all the world to witness; the other intensely private, glimpsed at by only a few.

Innocent young men are molded into soldiers by ingenious craftsmen, through a process of "dehumanize & reconstruct" into professional killing machines. But in times of peace that process is never reversed, i.e. "deconstruct & re-humanize" into functioning members of society.

Chris Cocks' journey begins with Fireforce in which he catalogues his three years' combat experience in 3 Commando, The Rhodesian Light Infantry. His naivety destroyed by basic training he enters a unit often compared to the French Foreign Legion. This compelling account tells of the combat method developed by the Rhodesians, & perfected by the RLI, involving airborne troops parachuted into action against the never-ending tide of the guerrilla enemy. The mental & physical strain on a Fireforce soldier was almost unbearable – with ground troops always in desperately short supply, the same men were at times dropped into as many as three contacts a day.

Although Fireforce has been written with an unforgettable pathos & humour, it tells of face-to-face combat in the bush & death at point-blank range. It is a book, which does nothing to glamorize or glorify war.

Survival Course explores the brutal reality faced by a soldier when he realizes he's now just an ordinary man – no longer the hero, misunderstood by most & alone in his quest for the "normality" of civilian life. It is a downward spiral into self-recrimination & guilt, the nightmares eased only by the escapism of drug & alcohol abuse. But ultimately the battle is a story of hope & re-awakening.

Although these two books are completely juxtaposed their essence is so intertwined that one should not be perceived in isolation of the other, for no war leaves a soldier unscarred & no self-destruction is without source.
